## **LAUNCH OF HELLOFLIGHT.COM MAKES REAL-TIME FAA FLIGHT DATA AVAILABLE TO U.S. TRAVELERS**

**Louisville, KY** – This season, holiday travelers have a new online tool to determine the official status of their airline flights. [HelloFlight.com](http://HelloFlight.com) accesses live data directly from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to track the real-time location of all commercial and most private aircrafts on the U.S. air traffic control system. Thus, travelers sitting in terminals awaiting the inbound arrival of a flight from its previous destination or family members eagerly anticipating loved ones flight arrivals can see exactly where an aircraft is located and can determine precisely when it will arrive.

- Movie viewer animation of live flights or archived flights on an interactive map with various playback controls
- Total number of aircrafts currently in U.S. airspace
- Filter options by aircraft type, airline, and private or commercial aircraft

- Airport statistics including the percentage of flights cancelled, delayed and on-time
- Average delays for an airport for the previous month
- Total number of aircrafts through an airport in the last month

A high resolution PDF is generated based on the flight number and depicts the terminal maps for both departure and arrival airports, weather forecast of the destination, driving maps to the airport, seating charts for the specific plane type, as well as restaurants, attractions, and events taking place in the destination city
